

ROYAL MUSSELBURGH GC OPEN COMPETITIONS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A precis covering all RMGC Gents, Ladies or Mixed Open competitions is downloadable from the RMGC website, and sets out the format, entry fee etc. for each competition. All applications for entry must be made via the RMGC website using BRS online booking.

The following additional terms and conditions apply:

1. All competitors must be a member of, or affiliated to, a Golf Club to enter. CDH numbers must be provided with entry and proof of current handicap index may be required before distribution of prizes.
2. Gents Open Pairs and Open Mixed Foursomes Entrants must be aged 18 or over on the day of the competition.
3. The 18 hole Scratch "Willie Park" Putter has a **Handicap Index** maximum of 8.6. Gents with a Handicap Index above 8.6 are not permitted to enter this competition. RMGC Council reserves the right to amend the qualifying Handicap Index in the light of entries received.
4. Gents Senior Open and Junior Open. These competitions have age related category prizes in addition to the prizes for overall winners. Entrants **must** record their age on their scorecard to be eligible for these additional prizes
5. For all competitions Ladies have a maximum Handicap Index of 32. All Gents competitions have a maximum Handicap Index of 25 apart from the Willie Park Putter (See Note 3 above.). Mixed competitions have a Handicap Index maximum of Ladies 32 and Gents 25.
6. All Senior Texas Scramble teams can be either 4 Gents, 4 Ladies or any combination.
7. RMGC reserves the right to amend times booked, either by post or via BRS, to optimise the times available and the duration of the competition.
8. Full Terms and Conditions for the Ladies competitions will be displayed on the notice board on the day of the competition.
9. No refunds will be made for cancellations within 7 days of the competition.
10. **Late entries.** Entries received within 7 days of the date of each competition will be considered at the discretion of RMGC.
11. **Dress code.** Golf shoes must be worn on the course. Shorts must be tailored and knee-length. jeans, tracksuits, football colours and collarless shirts are not permitted on the course. (Ladies are allowed to wear collarless shirts on the course.)
12. The RMGC Council (or the Ladies Committee, as appropriate) shall determine any difficulty which may arise in connection with any Open competition and its decision will be final. Should a competition be cancelled or abandoned, competitors will (within 10 days to allow a new date to be selected) be notified of the new date that it will be played. Those unable to play on the rearranged date will receive a refund at that time.
